



HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC CHURCH PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL-NOMINATION FORM

Qualification: Persons called to the important work of furthering the faith growth and Mission of the parish community should be open to the following:

- † Awareness to their personal call to the faith.
- † Willingness to participate in an orientation process to the parish pastoral council.
- † A commitment to help carry out the Mission statement of our parish.
- † A willingness to acquaint themselves with the role of the laity as outlined in the Documents of the Church.
- † A willingness to collaborate with the pastor, who is the leader of the parish community, and with the pastoral team, the members of the council, and parish committees.
- † A willingness to serve the common good of the whole parish community rather than advocating a special interest or specific committee.
- † A recognition of the relationship of the parish to diocesan and universal Church and the need for ongoing communication between the parish and the larger Church.

Note: The above qualifications set a vision for how council members can grow in providing leadership for the parish. All nominees (whether nominated by someone else or self-nominated) must be at least 18 years of age, active members of Holy Spirit Parish, and willing to serve for a three-year term.

DISCERNMENT AND FORMATION: There will be two sessions for discernment and formation for the new Parish Pastoral Council nominees. These sessions will be on Thursday, March 31, 2005 from 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. and on Sunday, April 17, 2005 from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. All nominees are required to attend these two sessions, unless other arrangements have been made with Father Jerry. Failure to attend the sessions or make other arrangements with Father Jerry will result in your withdrawal from further consideration.
